The type of personal information we collect

We collect and process the following information from people who sign our petition::

- Full name
- E-mail address
- Telephone number
- Postal code of home address (because LB Barnet require all petitioners to be Barnet residents)

How we get the personal information and why we have it

The personal information we process is provided to us directly by you (‘the Campaign Petitioners’) for the following reason:

- To identify all Barnet residents who support the “Cut-to-20mph” Campaign in Whetstone, London N20

We use the information that you have given us to demonstrate to Barnet Council the extent of demand from Barnet residents for reducing to 20 mph the traffic speed limits around the seven schools in Oakleigh Road North, Oakleigh Park South, Friern Barnet Lane, Myddelton Park and the residential roads within that area.

We will not share this information with anyone other than the Council of the London Borough of Barnet, when presenting the “Cut-to-20mph” petition to them in 2021.

Under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the lawful basis we rely on to process this information is **your consent, signified by your signing the petition in support of the “Cut-to-20mph” Campaign. You are able to remove your consent at any time. You can do this by contacting us at the above contact address, or by using the button on the website.**

How we store your personal information

Your information is securely stored. The Cut to 20 mph Campaign is committed to ensuring that the privacy of respondents and of any other individuals whose Information comes into it’s possession is protected. Information will only be used by the Campaign in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

All Information, both in digital and paper form, is held securely by the Campaign on relevant organisation computers and filing systems.

The Cut to 20 mph Campaign may change this Privacy Policy from time to time by updating this document.

This Privacy Policy is effective from 1st September 2020

We will keep your name, e-mail, postcode, and phone number securely until our “Cut-to-20mph” Campaign has been successful, or until we decide that the Campaign will no longer pursue our objective. We will then dispose your information by deleting all data on the relevant organisation computers and filing systems. At no time will your information be shared with any third party.

Your data protection rights

Under data protection law, you have rights including:

Your right of access - You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal information.

Your right to rectification - You have the right to ask us to rectify personal information you think is inaccurate. You also have the right to ask us to complete information you think is incomplete.

Your right to erasure - You have the right to ask us to erase your personal information in certain circumstances.

Your right to restriction of processing - You have the right to ask us to restrict the processing of your personal information in certain circumstances.

Your right to object to processing - You have the the right to object to the processing of your personal information in certain circumstances.

Your right to data portability - You have the right to ask that we transfer the personal information you gave us to another organisation, or to you, in certain circumstances.

You are not required to pay any charge for exercising your rights. If you make a request, we have one month to respond to you.
